Paul Drohan discussed the following:

- Education Resource – Youth related (Out tonight? Party Right?) – can be viewed on the OLGR website
- Benefit for Youth & Community – 8 lessons related to alcohol (binge drinking & partying)
- Information for the Liquor Accords
- RSA/Competency cards – staff must carry cards with them at all shifts worked
- Self-audit checklists – suggest do audit once a month
- Register on line to receive electronic newsletters
- Incident registers must be kept up to-date

GUEST SPEAKER – ROLAND HANDEL – VENUE BADGE

Roland Handel (CEO & Founder) from Venue Badge discussed the following:

- Fake Identification
- VenueSafe – scan, read & store an ID
 - Check, process & verify data on the ID
 - Record information against patron
 - Capture photo
 - Record time & date of entry
 - Interrogate data real-time
- VenueSafe Solutions/Workflow
 - Age verification
 - Security licence check
 - Competency card sign-off
 - Concierge management
- Information captured
 - ID details & verification check
 - Photo of patron
 - Gender
 - Admit or reject
- Sharing information
 - Run as a standalone solution – stored locally
 - Share data across venues
- Privacy & security
 - Adhere to Australia Privacy Principles
- Reporting
 - Entries by week
 - Entries by age
 - Entries by LGA
- Benefits
 - Compliance & validation (security)
 - Real time reporting
 - Staffing & operations
 - Marketing

GUEST SPEAKER – SERGEANT BEN BLACKBURN – TRAFFIC SUPERVISOR

Sergeant Ben Blackburn discussed the following:

- Traffic issues
- New laws on mobile phones while driving
- New rules on roundabouts
- Drink driving penalties
- Road side drug testing

GUEST SPEAKER – SENIOR CONSTABLE LUKE O'HARA – DOG UNIT

Senior Constable Luke O'Hara spoke about actions to be taken when police attend a licensed premise, how dogs are trained to identify patrons if they are under the influence of drugs.

- End of next year – 95% occupancy rate at SOP – currently 65%
