The Chairman Peter Denmead declared the meeting opened at 10.35am.

**REVIEW MINUTES OF MEETING HELD 13<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2013**

**RESOLVED:** That the minutes held 13<sup>th</sup> November 2013 be adopted as a true and correct record of proceedings.

**Senior Constable Paul Aishou – FLEMINGTON LAC Presentation**

Senior Constable Paul Aishou provided a brief presentation on alcohol related crimes. He stated the following:

- From November 2013 to January 2014, alcohol related crimes peaked on Saturday nights
- From November 2013 to January 2014 alcohol related crimes were 8% of all incidents (which is slightly higher from previous months).

A consumption report was also presented with, 20% of drivers stating a licenced premise is the last place they consumed alcohol.

**Senior Constable Paul Aishou – FAIL TO QUIT**

A brief discussion was then held on issues surrounding “fail to quit”. Senior Constable Paul Aishou recommended all members to advise their staff, management and security to physically go outside the premises to discourage an excluded person from re-entering the premises. It was also recommended that members remind their staff and security of the legal conditions of an exclusion.

**Senior Constable Paul Aishou - KEY CHANGES FOR THE INDUSTRY**

A brief discussion was held on the key changes:

- Online RSA training courses will be suspended until further notice. It was identified that there needs to be a way of verifying the individual completing the test.
- New industry laws commenced 24<sup>th</sup> February 2014:

- Takeaway liquor cannot be sold after 10pm in NSW
- A lock out in the CBD and Kings Cross precinct will commence at 1.30am.
- Last drinks that can be sold on premises is 3am.
- A discussion on the exemption threshold then followed. Senior Constable Paul Aishou hoped by next meeting an exemption threshold can be provided to committee members.
- The topic then changed to the Periodic licencing scheme: The government will consider scheme details and periodic fee amounts during the first quarter of 2014. Further details will be provided to committee members in due course.

**Peter Denmend - FLEMINGTON LIQUOR ACCORD**

Late last year the Accord Terms and patron conduct Conditions were drafted for members of the Flemington Liquor Accord. The Chairman explained that signing is completely voluntary. A discussion then followed as to whether the code of conduct is applicable to all premises. The Chairman suggested all attendees to take the draft copies away with them and to provide feedback by the next meeting.
